## SURVEY RESPONSES FOR MARCH 2022

Text message poll sent to ~1,000 Santa Monicans between March 23-28, with a response rate of 17 percent.

### QUESTION 1:

The California Coastal Commission unanimously approved plans for the redevelopment of the 100-year-old Miramar Hotel. The development would include larger guest rooms and the addition of 60 luxury condos, a new affordable housing complex on 2nd Street, and three levels of underground parking, along with street-level improvements like a public green space. Do you support or oppose this development?
