

## SANTA MONICA PULSE SURVEY RESPONSES FOR NOVEMBER 2022

Text message poll sent to ~1,000 Santa Monicans between Nov. 21 - Dec. 2, with a response rate of 14 percent.

## **QUESTION 1:**

Two local interest groups, Santa Monicans for Renters' Rights and Unite Here Local 11, ran an aggressive campaign against Councilmember Lana Negrete this past election cycle. Did their campaign make you more or less likely to vote for Coucilmember Negrete?
