Text message poll sent to ~1,000 Santa Monicans between Jan 31 - Feb 5 with a response rate of 11 percent.

QUESTION 1:

Hospitality worker union Unite Here Local 11 recently failed to get enough signatures for a ballot initiative that would have required Santa Monica hotels to pay their workers \$30 an hour. The union has also been active in recent months organizing loud, early-morning protests in residential areas. Would you say that Local 11 has been a positive or negative influence in Santa Monica?
