Text message poll sent to ~1,000 Santa Monicans between Apr 26 - Apr 30 with a response rate of 12 percent.

QUESTION 1:

Earlier this month, the City Council approved the development of a 122-unit apartment building for the homeless. It will cost more than \$1 million per unit, making it one of the most expensive affordable housing projects in the nation. Located at the former site of Parking Structure 3 Downtown, the project will be financed with Federal, State and County funding, loans, tax credits and tax-exempt bonds. Do you support the construction of this affordable housing project?
